

# **Directions from the Humberto Delgado Airport**

- The Lisbon Airport has a Metro (subway) station with a direct line to the city centre. The 'Aeroporto Saldanha' line takes you to downtown Lisbon in about 20 minutes. Plan your journey <a href="here">here</a>.
- <u>Coimbra Airport Shuttle</u> operates a door-to-door shared transfer between the Center of Portugal and both Lisbon and Oporto airports.
- 10 minutes away by Metro and a bit longer by bus, you can get to <u>Gare do</u>
   <u>Oriente</u>, the main train station in Lisbon, where you can take trains to all parts of the country.
- <u>Several bus lines</u> stop at the airport arrivals terminal, taking you to different parts of the city. However, please note that the maximum baggage size allowed in these buses is 50x40x20cm.





Even if you're an introvert, don't stay quiet. Fun fact: people who actively participate always enjoy the conference the most. Join the workshops and discussions!



# **Must-see Places**

### **Alfama**

Wonderful sights delight walkers at every turn, which through its architecture reminds visitors of its Visigothic roots, Arabic influence and fishing port heritage.



### Mosteiro dos Jeronimos

This is a masterpiece of Manueline and Gothic architecture in 1502 near the Tagus river, which was inspired by Vasco da Gama who is buried here with other great navigators of the past.



### Torre de Belém

A 16th-century tower which serves as a monument to Portugal's Age of Discovery on both land and sea. Since 1983, the tower has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site



### Museu Nacional do Azulejo

A must-see for people interested in the history and design of ceramic tiles, this specialty museum houses a splendid collection of decorative tiles dating from the 15th century.



### **Praca do Comercio**

One of the biggest squares in Europe, this stylish area in downtown Lisbon often displays beautiful works of art and sculpture, and is a great place for a leisurely stroll.
